## Access

### [The nearest station]

10 min walk from Ikegami station on the Tokyu Ikegami line.

20 min walk from Nishimagome station on the Toei Asakusa line.

### [From Shinagawa station to Ikegami station: about 20 minutes]

Take the JR Keihin Tohoku line to Kamata station and change to the Tokyu Ikegami line.

### [From Shinjuku station to Nishimagome station: about 30 minutes]

Take the JR Yamanote line to Gotanda station and change to the Toei Asakusa line.

### [From Asakusa station to Nishimagome station: about 30 minutes]

Take the Toei Asakusa line to Nishimagome station.
