About Bicycle Impoundment

Ordinance

Ota City asks everyone who rides a bicycle to refrain from parking in public areas (such as roads, parks, railway station plazas, or any other place that is not a designated bicycle parking area) based on the "Ota City Ordinance on the Proper Use of Bicycles, etc., and Maintenance of Parking Lots for Bicycles, etc."

This is because bicycles left in public areas create various problems: They block the way for children, senior citizens, and people with disabilities. They can fall over and injure pedestrians. And they can interfere with the passage of emergency vehicles in an emergency.

For these reasons, be sure to park your bicycle in a bicycle parking area, even when only stopping for a short time.

Areas where leaving bicycles is prohibited

The ordinance also designates certain areas of Ota City as "prohibited zones for parking bicycles, etc." and stipulates that Ota City can impound bicycles that are left in those zones.

Prohibited zones are mainly established near railway stations, such as Kamata Station and Omori Station. They are marked by signs like the one shown in the photograph.



If your bicycle has been impounded

Ota City generally stores impounded bicycles for 30 days. Please note that bicycles will be disposed of once this storage period has expired.

If a bicycle has been registered for theft prevention, Ota City will send a postcard to the home of its owner to provide notification of impoundment. However, no notification can be sent for unregistered bicycles.

Theft-prevention registration is required under the Act on Promotion of Safe Use of Bicycles and Comprehensive Advancement of Measures for Bicycle Parking. If you have not registered your bicycle, please do so at a local bicycle shop.

Impounded Bicycle Storage Centers

There are four Impounded Bicycle Storage Centers in Ota City. The center to which a bicycle will be taken differs depending on where the bicycle was left. Details are provided below.
