## Notice ➤ The Multilingual Consultation Desk is Here to Help

At the Multilingual Consultation Desk, you can consult about everyday concerns in a variety of languages. For a fee, we can also translate documents you are submitting to the Ota City Office into Japanese.

### ① General consultations

(free of charge, no reservation required)

Service hours: Weekdays 10:00 am to 5:00 pm

### ② Professional consultations with an attorney

(free of charge, reservation required)

#### • Consultation hours:

1:00 pm to 5:00 pm on the first and third Sundays of each month

• Languages available: English, Chinese, Tagalog

If you need to consult a staff member in a language that is not available, please ask at the desk in advance.

### ③ Document translation

We will translate documents you are submitting to the Ota City Office into Japanese.

\* We cannot translate documents intended for submission to embassies or immigration offices.

We also do not offer same-day translation.
