Please consult us before purchasing.

We provide subsidies for the purchase and installation of air conditioners for households that find it difficult to purchase air conditioners for economic reasons, with the aim of preventing health damage caused by the heatstroke.

Heatstroke Prevention

We recommend applying **as soon as possible!**

Applications will be accepted from **June 1, 2026!!**

If you purchased before June 1, 2026, please consult with us.

Eligible households

Households with no air conditioners installed that can be used at home, and with the resident registration in Ota City on the application date and the air conditioner installation completion date, that fall under any of the following categories I to III

- I Households exempt from resident tax
- II Households subject only to the per capita resident tax
- III Households receiving child-rearing allowance

Households receiving public welfare assistance should contact the responsible Social Welfare Division.

- ★Expenses exceeding the subsidy limit must be paid out of your own expense.
- ★If you live in a rental property, you must obtain the landlord's consent.

Process from Application to Subsidy

Step 1 Telephone consultation

We will explain in detail whether you meet the grant requirements, so please first contact the dedicated call center.

Step 2 Application

After confirming the relevant requirements at the call center, please apply to the local welfare section that has jurisdiction over your area of residence.

Step 3 Home visit survey



On the date and time of the scheduled visit survey, ward staff or a surveyor commissioned by the city will visit your home to check the installation status of the air conditioner. The surveyor will carry identification.

Step 4 Approval Decision

As a result of home visits and other investigations, households confirmed to be eligible for subsidies will be sent the "Ota City Air Conditioner Installation Emergency Support Project Grant Decision Notice."

Step 5 Purchase and Installation

Please bring the "Ota City Emergency Air Conditioner Installation Support Project Grant Approval Notice" with you when purchasing your desired air conditioner from a retailer and having it installed.

- ①By authorizing a contractor commissioned by the ward to receive the subsidy on your behalf, you will not need to pay the amount equivalent to the subsidy (up to 100,000 yen).
- ②By using Tokyo Zero Emission Points, you can lower the base price.

Step 6 Grant Claim and Notification of Grant Amount

After installation, please submit a grant claim along with the required documents. Note that if you have delegated the grant claim and receipt to a dealer, you do not need to submit a claim. After the ward verifies the claim details, it will determine the grant amount and notify you.

Step 7 Installation and Grant Disbursement

The amount stated in the grant determination notice will be transferred to your designated bank account. If you have authorized the dealer to receive the grant on your behalf, the dealer will receive the funds.

Q&A

Q All other subsidy requirements have been met, but the air conditioner was purchased before June 1. Does that mean it is not eligible for the subsidy?

A If the purchase is made on or after April 1, 2026, it may be eligible for the subsidy, so please contact the call center first.

Q I am unaware of my household's tax status. Is it necessary to verify this in advance, for example by obtaining a certificate of exemption, before submitting the application?

A After receiving the application form, the city will verify the tax information, so it is not necessary for you to check it yourself before applying. Please note that we cannot confirm your identity, and therefore cannot provide responses regarding tax information over the phone.

Q The air conditioner is installed, but it is broken and cannot be used. Is it eligible for the subsidy?

A During the home visit survey, we will check whether it is broken and cannot be used. If it is determined that it is not suitable for repair, it may be eligible for the subsidy. Please note that for air conditioner malfunctions, consult an electronics store first.
